CHRISTMAS ACTIVITIES

Christmas is always a busy time for both the children and you, their families. We want to make sure that no-one misses any of the exciting events we have planned and so this newsletter details our plans for the Christmas Activities.

This year we will again be having separate Christmas productions for each year group. This will mean that there will only be one performance for each year group. In the week beginning 3rd December we will be sending home **two adult tickets per family** for the production your child is taking part in. (If you do not require both tickets please return one to the office and we will set up a waiting list for extra tickets).

We would appreciate it if you could attend without younger children as this can distract the children performing. However, if you have to bring younger children we do ask that you are considerate to the children performing. If your child is disrupting the play, please would you take them out, so as not to spoil it for the children and other families. Thank you for your support in this. Younger children will require a ticket for fire regulations. Please make sure that you have a ticket for them by completing and returning the attached slip.

The performance dates and times are as follows:

Early Years production (The Vegetable Patch, Hedgerow & Nursery): Tuesday 18th December 9.30am

Year 1 production (Giraffes & Lions): Monday 17th December 2.15pm

Year 2 production (Wallaby's & Koalas): Monday 17th December 9.30am

The **use of cameras** during the children's performance can be intrusive and irritate other members of the audience. We are therefore happy to offer all our parents an opportunity to take photographs at the end of the production.

Christmas Lunch - Wednesday, 19th December.

This year as all school lunches are free the Christmas lunch will be free also. However due to ordering the food we need to know numbers for the Christmas lunch in advance.

CHRISTMAS PARTY
