

## SCHOOL CLOTHING

PLEASE MARK EVERY ITEM OF SCHOOL CLOTHING WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME.

Items of clothing and footwear should be easy for your child to manage themselves.

### School Dress Code

There is no compulsory school uniform but almost all our families adopt the school dress code:

#### Winter

Grey or black skirt, trousers or pinafore.

White or blue blouse or shirt.

Royal blue jumper, cardigan or sweatshirt with or without school logo.

Grey, black or white socks or tights.



#### Summer

Blue and white dress or short sleeved shirt.

Grey, black, navy or royal blue short trousers.

White, grey or blue socks.

#### Wellies and Waterproofs

We aim to use our outdoor areas to learn in as much as possible so we ask all children to bring a pair of named wellies to leave at school and ask that all children daily bring a coat. We do have a small number of waterproofs available on very wet days. We also ask that children have a sun hat to wear outside on sunny days.

#### Overalls

The school provides long sleeved, waterproof overalls for Art and Design and Technology and aprons for cooking.
