

SAFETY IN SCHOOL

You are about to become members of our school community.
We ask that every parent considers his/her conduct in respect of the safety of **ALL** our children. The children will learn from your example.

PLEASE use care and courtesy when driving or parking.

- ❖ Do not park on zigzag lines, disabled bays or in the school entrance or the school grounds including the **staff carpark**.
- ❖ Do not double park in The Drive, with particular reference to the laybys.
- ❖ Do not use the school entrance for turning.
- ❖ Do not park in front of garages and gates in the roads around school including Chichester Close, The Drive and Bramble Close.
- ❖ If you have access needs please see the school office to discuss your needs.

PLEASE REMEMBER

- ❖ Always use the pedestrian entrances at the front or back of the school at the beginning and end of the day. Use the front pedestrian entrance during the school day and close all gates behind you even if other parents are following. Never climb over gates or fences or allow your child to do so.
- ❖ Do not cross the carpark or enter the grounds by the blue carpark gate, **instead** use the **pathway** that goes from the juniors to our school behind the Junior carpark.
- ❖ **No dogs** are allowed in the grounds.
- ❖ **DO NOT** ride bicycles or tricycles or scooters in the grounds at any point before or after school.
- ❖ If possible please leave prams and pushchairs outside the building.
- ❖ Always use the paths and please walk in front of the white line down the side of the school.
- ❖ **DO NOT** allow children to climb on the pillars by the front gate.

PLEASE REMEMBER

- ❖ **YOU** are responsible for the behaviour of your younger children at all times.
- ❖ **YOU** are responsible for the behaviour of **ALL** your children in the grounds before and after school, even if a member of staff is outside.
- ❖ You may sit in the Leopard's Lodge but please **DO NOT** allow children to climb on it or the Tiger's Trail blackboards.
- ❖ We have a lot of plants growing - please respect this by sticking to paths and designated areas.
- ❖ The staff may have set up learning activities outside, please respect this by not moving equipment.

Health and Safety measures for Physical Education.

All parents are expected to comply with these Health and Safety measures:

- ❖ Long hair should be tied back.
- ❖ Children with a verruca should wear plimsolls.
- ❖ No jewellery should be worn.

We ask you **PLEASE** not to have your child's ears pierced.

If your child already has pierced ears we ask you to remove them on PE days, if they have recently been pierced they can have their earrings covered by tape until it is safe to remove them.

Hampshire's policy states that:

'With very young children, parents should be asked to remove earrings and studs from children's ears before they come to school each day, until such time as their child is able to remove these adornments themselves prior to a PE lesson. It is the responsibility of parents to train their children to take out and put in studs and sleepers.' HCC 1997

Children who do not have their earrings removed will not be able to participate in P.E.
